Friday, 02 December 2022

As we approach the end of the Autumn Term, I would like to share our plans for the final week of term. In light of us taking 102 Year 8 and Year 9 pupils to France we have decided to restructure our timetable to allow other pupils to enjoy a shopping trip if they wish to do so. Many pupils requested a trip to Meadowhall last year but unfortunately due to COVID we had to cancel. The final week of term will be as follows:

### Monday 12th December 2022

Pupils will have the opportunity to go on a Christmas shopping trip to Meadowhall. The cost of the coach is £10 per pupil. If you would like your child to attend please pay via ParentPay by **Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2022.** 

The coach will be leaving school at 8.45 a.m. and will return to school by the end of the school day at 2.55 p.m. Pupils will not be expected to wear school uniform if they take part in this visit. If your child does not want to attend they will be expected to attend school as normal in full school uniform.

The school bus will leave as normal at 3.05 p.m.

## Tuesday 13th December 2022

Pupils will follow their normal timetabled lessons apart from Period 3 when their Humanities lessons have been replaced by PE. Pupils will be expected to attend in full school uniform and **bring their PE kit with them**. There will be **no enrichment after school on this day**. The **school bus will leave at 3.05 p.m.** and there will be no bus at 4 p.m.
