The Suthers School Enrichment – Term 1

Apps for Good (30 places)

Create an app that aims to act on climate change. Our new solutions focused technology course educates young people about the climate crisis, enables them to take action and prepares them for green jobs of the future.

Young Enterprise (30 places)

Young Enterprise provides young people with the skills, competencies and mindset to make the most of everyday opportunities. For the first term, our Young Enterprise club will be planning, producing and marketing products ahead of a Christmas Market event.

STEM (20 places)

Students will have the opportunity to explore subjects like science, technology, engineering and maths in less formal settings.

Journalism (20 places)

Students will be planning, writing and publishing a termly newsletter about all things Suthers. This will include puzzles, interviews, articles, competitions and more.

Cricket (30 places)

Students will learn how to play cricket. In the event of poor weather/lack of light, students will be in a classroom learning about the theory of cricket and analysing match play.

Basketball (30 places)

Students will learn how to play basketball. This will include some classroom learning about the theory of basketball and analysing match play.

Netball (30 places)

Students will learn how to play netball. In the event of poor weather/lack of light, students will be in a classroom learning about the theory and strategy of netball and analysing match play.

Chess (20 places)

Students will be learning about the game of chess and analysing games, as well as playing their own games of chess.

Amnesty Club/WE Club (30 places)

Students will be learning about and researching different charitable causes and carrying out fundraising and awareness-raising campaigns.

German (30 places)

Students will be learning about the German language and about German culture.

Strategy Board Games (20 places)

Students will be competing against each other in different strategy-based board games.

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Anatomy of Typography (15 places)

This enrichment option will explore the origins of the written word, from Egyptian glyphs, medieval calligraphy and illuminated manuscripts, through to graffiti and wider abstract interpretation of this beautiful art form.

Baking Club (20 places)

Each week, students will be baking a delicious treat!

Rugby (30 places)

Students will learn how to play rugby. In the event of poor weather/lack of light, students will be in a classroom learning about the theory of rugby and analysing match play.

Boxing (15 places)

Students will have an experienced boxing coach to provide boxing lessons.

Creative Writing (30 places)

Students will take part in various activities, including national creative writing and poetry competitions.
