**Conduct on The Suthers School Bus**

As many of you will be aware, there have been a number of behaviour incidents on the bus recently. Despite sanctions, repeated reminders, Road Safety Awareness lessons and random spot checks, I am still receiving complaints about the amount of noise and potentially unsafe behaviour from Suthers School students when travelling on the bus.

I am therefore writing to advise that from Monday 12 November, any further instance of poor behaviour / failure to abide by our Code of Conduct on the bus to or from school will result in an immediate fixed-term or permanent travel ban. Fixed-term bans will be for a minimum of one half term. We will be supported in the monitoring of this by CCTV and by ongoing spot-checks.

I have attached a copy of the Code of Conduct for travel on the bus, as devised with students at the start of the year, in order that you can discuss this with your child.
