I wanted to contact you all to provide an update on how Year 11 have been progressing as we approach the Christmas break.

I would like to acknowledge the hard work and dedication of students and staff over this first term. It has been an incredibly busy, but productive period for the year group.

Events such as the Year 11 Information and Achievement evening that took place at the beginning of term along with the more recent visit to the local Careers fair were a great success. The mock examination period demonstrated the commitment and focus of all students and it was great to celebrate their success in the mock results breakfast event that followed.

Additional sessions have been provided in a number of key subjects to support students and a selected cohort are now accessing online tuition in English and Maths through our partnership with MyTutor. This is alongside a comprehensive 1-1 tutoring programme that is in place to support students in school on a daily basis.

In school, the "Winning Leader" programme has now come to end and I would like to thank Gareth Morgan for the support and guidance provided for a number of our students this term.


Looking ahead, I am pleased to confirm the Year 11 Character and Academic success evening will take place on **Wednesday 18th January (4-6pm).**
