As we approach the start of a new term I wanted to share with you the fantastic achievements of our Year 11 students who received their GCSE results this week. I am delighted that for the second year running, over 70% of our students achieved a 4+ in English and Maths which has enabled most of them to progress on to their preferred pathway. I am also delighted with our strong set of results at 7+ in English and Maths which places us in the top 5% of similar schools nationally. Every half-term we run a Family Forum to take feedback from parents and carers. I have listened to the feedback in relation to the setting of Practice Learning (Homework). As of September, all subject teachers will be setting Practice Learning through the **My Child At School (MCAS) App**. This will allow you to support your child by knowing exactly what homework they have to complete and the deadlines for completing the homework.

To support our students to become more independent we will also be launching the **Bromcom Student Portal** and **Bromcom Student App**. The Student Portal will be accessible through a Computer or Laptop and the App will be available on Smart Phones. We will be completing this process when students return in September and it will then allow them to track and monitor their own homework.

If you would like your child to be able to access the Bromcom Student App via their Smartphone I would be grateful if you could ask them to download the app to their phones prior to returning to school. They will not be able to register and sign in to the app until they return to school and complete the registration process with their unique codes. The app can be downloaded from the **Google Play Store** or the **Apple App Store**. The app logo looks like this:
