

BUILDING SET TO START SOON!

This week we received the brilliant news that building work on the site of our permanent home in Fernwood will begin early in the new year. This long-awaited announcement is of course a really significant milestone in the school's history and means that we can now finalise plans for a turnover ceremony to mark the start of this exciting project!

As many of you will already have seen, the DFE approved the publication of a joint press release earlier this week which sets out the revised timeline for the completion of the build— our new building will be completed by Spring 2020 and whilst this is later than originally planned we are now working with the ESFA to determine the best short-term temporary arrangements for students, including the new Year 7 cohort we look forward to welcoming in September.
